

Enhanced Housekeeping / Sanitation Non-Clinical | COVID-19

1. The following high touch surfaces are disinfected 2-3 times daily with at least two times during the day shift and one time during the night shift in non-clinical facilities (See attached table).
 - a. Elevator Buttons
 - b. Handrails
 - c. Exterior Entry Doors
 - d. Restroom Doors, toilet handles, sink handles
 - e. Lobby high touch surfaces
 - f. Classroom high touch surfaces
 - g. Library

2. Staff should wear proper PPE for cleaning the areas:
 - a. Disposable gloves and closed-toe shoes for all tasks in the cleaning process. Gloves must be compatible with the disinfectant products.
 - b. Additional PPE might be required based on the cleaning/disinfectant products being used and whether there is a risk of splash.
 - c. Gloves should be removed carefully to avoid contamination of the wearer and the surrounding area. **Be sure to clean hands after removing gloves.**

3. All surfaces should be cleaned and disinfected (especially frequently touched surfaces):
 - a. All surfaces shall be cleaned using EPA listed disinfect from List N effective against SARS-COV-2 virus. The table may be found: <https://www.epa.gov/pesticide-registration/list-n-disinfectants-use-against-sars-cov-2>. **The Health Science Center's preferred disinfectant is VIREX II 256 with a wet contact time of 10 minutes (the product must remain on the surface for 10 minutes to properly disinfect the area).**

Elevators	Wipe down touch points – 2 times	Wipe down touch points - daily Sweep and mop - daily
Offices	Occupant to wipe down touch points (desks)	Occupant to wipe down desks Empty trash/spot vacuum - daily Vacuum - weekly
Labs	Occupant to wipe down touch points (surfaces)	Occupant to wipe down surfaces Empty trash - daily
Large Lecture Halls	Wipe down touch points – 1 time during day shift	Routine clean - daily Empty trash/spot vacuum - daily Vacuum - weekly
Library	Wipe down touch points – 2 times during day shift	Routine clean – daily Empty trash/spot vacuum – daily
